## BOOKS! BOOKS! BOOKS!

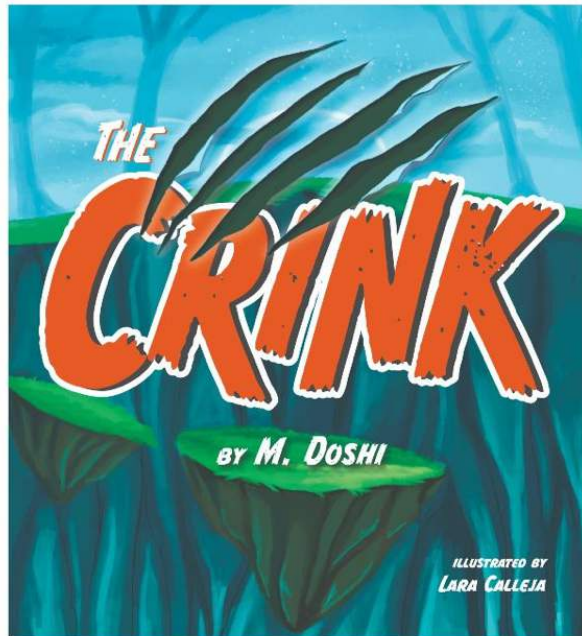
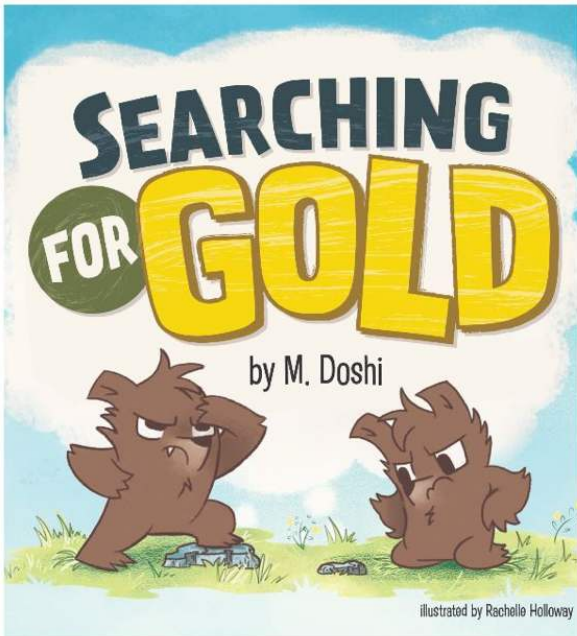

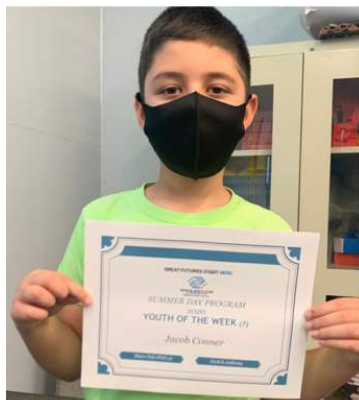
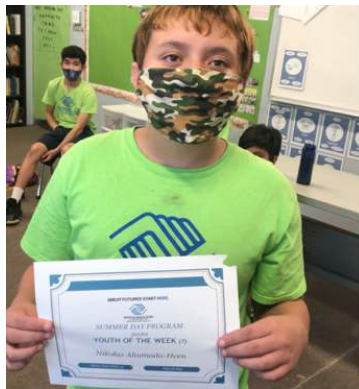
## Doshi Books for Kids, Inc.

## FALL REGISTRATION UPDATE

**Attention BUSD parents:** The school year is quickly approaching! Fall 2020 registration is open now through parent portal. The registration fee is \$85 for 20/21 school year. This is a nonrefundable fee served as a deposit to hold a spot for your child to attend our program for the upcoming school year. **We encourage you to register at your earliest convenience as there will be a huge need for childcare this fall and spots will be limited. Registering now holds your spot for fall.**

Please be advised that the Fall 2020 school schedule has not yet been finalized but we are basing it off of the information we have been provided which suggests there will be two school shifts a day ( Monday- Thursday) with Friday being a pupil free day. There will be an 8:10- 10:45 shift and a 12:10 – 2:45 shift. We know that with this schedule parents are going to need child care before and after school.

Currently the parent portal is only open for registration. As soon as the BUSD releases the fall schedule, we will send out information regarding the program session and pricing. You can then complete the enrollment on parent portal. Again, we understand the upcoming school schedule will present challenges for many of our parents. Our goal is to ensure our members have access to a safe, healthy and affordable enrichment program. We are working closely with Burbank Unified School District and will continue to provide updates.
