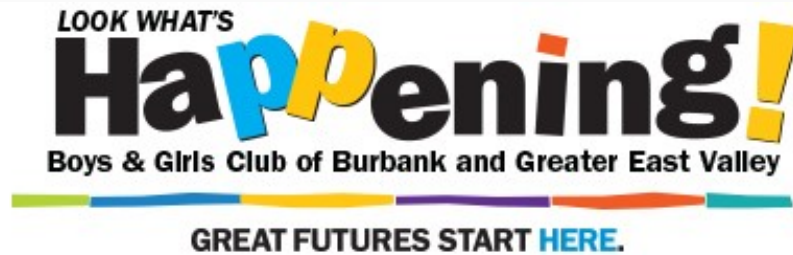

**Disclaimer:** In order to operate at each site, a minimum of 40 club members are required per session. If enrollment goals are not reached, parents will be able to enroll their child in a different location. Members must wear masks daily. For school session programs, members must bring own device and head sets for virtual learning or else devices will be provided to them. Members must also bring own refillable water bottle. **Stevenson, Jefferson, Edison, and Jordan are waiting list sites that will be opened if 40 members enroll per site. Therefore, please notify Priscilla if you are interested in attending these sites.**

Virtual School starts on Monday, August 17<sup>th</sup>. Registration and weekly services are available through parent portal. Our operating sites are, Main Club and Bret Harte.

The Main Club (over 7,500 sq/ft indoor space) with an outdoor basketball court and Bret Harte (two large bungalows) with green space and play areas, for your service. We will open other sites as soon as the enrollment increases.

Our Locations:

**Main Club:** 1<sup>st</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade

**Bret Harte:** TK – 5<sup>th</sup> grade

**Full Day program**, Monday – Friday from 7:30 a.m. – 6 p.m. We will provide supervision and assistance to members with their distance learning, class/homework, and provide BGC enrichment programs. Members must bring their own devices and headsets to participate in distance learning as scheduled by the School District. The device must be fully charged. Members must have their username and password. If your child does not have a device, please let us know ahead of time so we may provide one for the day. BGC has a limited number of devices for loan and will be on a first come first serve basis. The weekly fee for the **TK/K - Elementary program is \$185, and Middle school is \$150.**

**School Session program**, Monday – Thursday from 7:30 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. for elementary school members. Monday – Thursday from 7:30 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. for middle school members. We will provide supervision and assistance to members with their distance learning only and provide minimal class/homework assistance in between their class breaks. Members must bring their own device and headsets to participate in distance learning as scheduled by the School District. The device must be fully charged. Members must have their username and password. If your child does not have a device, please let us know ahead of time so we may provide one for

the day. BGC has a limited number of devices for loan and will be on a first come first serve basis. The weekly fee for the School Session **TK/K - Elementary program is \$150, and Middle school is \$125.**

**Enrichment program**, Monday – Thursday from 2:30 p.m. – 6 p.m. and Fridays, 7:30 a.m. – 6 p.m. for elementary school members. Monday – Thursday from 3:00 p.m. – 6 p.m. and Fridays, 7:30 a.m. – 6 p.m. for middle school members. This program will provide class /homework assistance and BGC enrichment programs. Members must bring their class/homework materials. The weekly fee for the School Session **TK/K - Elementary program is \$120, and Middle school is \$50.**

Program for incoming high school and high school members are free. Although services are free, parents are required to enroll each week to ensure they are accounted for.

Parents must enroll and purchase their weekly service by Friday, 5 p.m. so their child can attend Monday of the following week. In order for each site to operate each week, a minimum of 40 club members (30 for Edison) are required per session. If enrollment goals are not met, parents will be able to enroll their child at a different location.

Members are required to wear their masks daily and bring their own refillable water bottle. The club will provide one mask to each member on their first day, but it will be the responsibility of each parent to provide a face mask for their children for the remainder of the school year. If your child is medically exempted from wearing a mask, parents must provide documentation in writing.

**Financial aid** is available to families who qualify. Applications are available on our [website](#). Financial aid comes in varying increments that will help cover the weekly fee. Aid does not cover the registration fee. Parents will be responsible for the registration and weekly fee prior to the first day of your child's attendance to the program. ### **Snacks and Lunch**

The club will provide a morning and afternoon snack for all locations. *Lunch will only be provided for the Main Club.* For all other site, parents will need to provide a sack lunch. As a reminder, the club does not heat nor refrigerate food for club

For parents who drop off food or use a food service company, please remember lunch is from noon – 12:45 pm. We are on a schedule and all members will only eat lunch during lunch time.

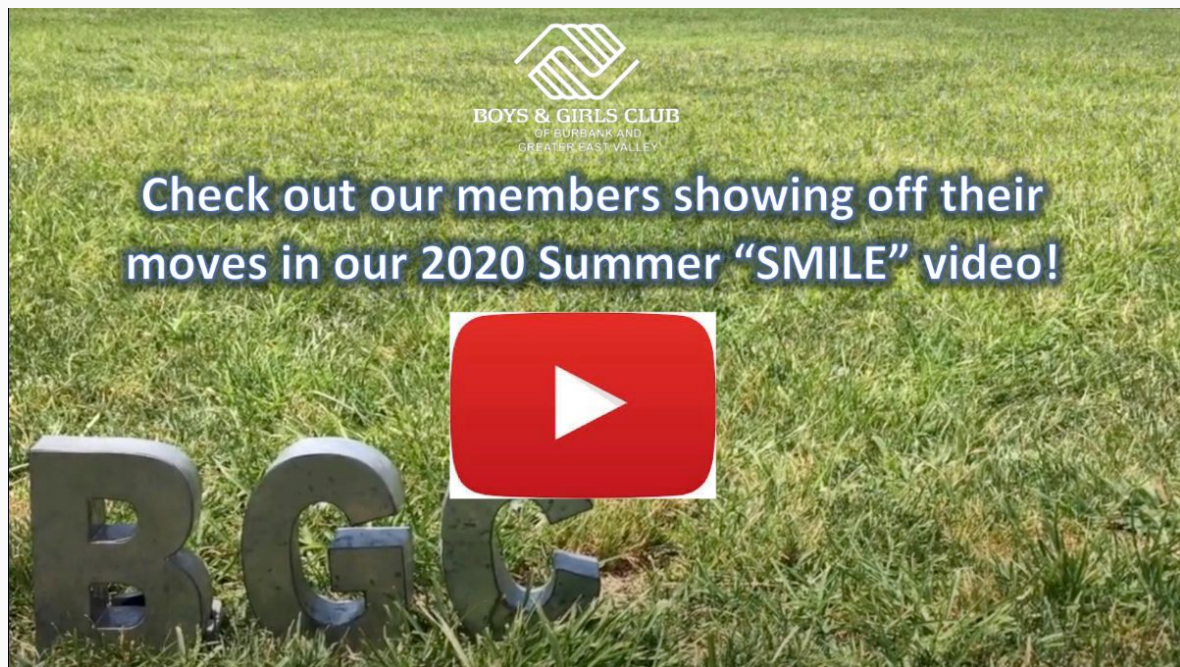
