



### **CLUB SAFETY UPDATE**

Recently, our Boys & Girls Club participated in The Boys & Girls Clubs of America's Quality Assurance Safety Pilot Initiative. The purpose of this pilot is to 1) test the new quality assurance process at 100+ locations representing a variety of site types, budget sizes and regions, 2) evaluate the safety assessment tool/process and, 3) gain acceptance from various stakeholders. "We were excited to be part of the pilot program," said Board Member Mathew Poage, also a member of the Safety Committee. He added, "The safety of our members is our first priority at the Club. It's an honor to be one of the first clubs to be working with BGCA on implementing their new and innovative safety protocols. This is an exciting opportunity to be on the forefront of a new safety movement. It's a win-win for everyone."

Some high level observations about our Club include but are not limited to:

All policies are in place and staff can articulate emergency response plan contents, are aware and can recall safety drills recently implemented

- All staff are First Aid and CPR certified
- LiveScan is being used for all background checks
- Front line staff can articulate strong Covid protocols; very stringent COVID-19 protocols are in place for all kids and adults onsite
- CEO was tremendously thorough in providing documents for review. Our Club's documentation procedures set the national standard for BGCA.
- Board and CEO leadership eager to enhance safety strategy & overall safety improvement
- planning

While we are pleased with our current evaluation, our commitment to safety is strong. This is only the beginning. We will continue to improve on our high standards by implementing more layers of protection, such as:

- Staff and Youth Councils
- Robust Training and Learning events, to continue targeted training
- · Annual Background Checks, assessments and reviews
- Board led Safety Committee






### **MANNERS MATTER**

# CUIDADO INFANTIL PARA TRABAJADORES ESENCIALES Y DE BAJOS INGRESOS



La Junta de Supervisores del Condado de Los Angeles y la Ciudad de Los Angeles han dedicado parte de sus fondos de la ley CARES para brindar servicios de cuidado infantil (subsidios) para trabajadores esenciales y padres trabajadores de bajos ingresos durante la pandemia de COVID-19. Child Care Alliance of Los Angeles (CCALA) y sus agencias asociadas distribuirán estos fondos a los trabajadores esenciales elegibles.

### Las familias elegibles deben ser:

ELIGIBILIDAD

DISPONIBILIDAD

- Trabajadores esenciales o familias trabajadoras de bajos ingresos (el trabajador esencial incluye: padres / tutor legal que trabajan en servicios esenciales como la industria del cuidado de la salud, servicios de emergencia, alimentos y agricultura y otros negocios actualmente abiertos según las pautas más recientes del Gobernador)
- Debe vivir en el condado de Los Ángeles
- Necesitan cuidado infantil para realizar su trabajo esencial
- No puede trabajar de forma remota
- · Cumplir con ciertos requisitos de ingresos
- Si la familia incluye un hogar de dos padres, ambos padres deben ser trabajadores esenciales o el otro padre debe ser incapaz de cuidar al niño debido a una incapacidad.

Las familias que cumplen con los requisitos de elegibilidad pueden recibir servicios de cuidado infantil de emergencia para sus hijos hasta el 30 de diciembre de 2020.
