## LA COUNTY FINANCIAL NAVIGATORS

### L.A. COUNTY FINANCIAL NAVIGATORS

The COVID-19 pandemic has had a major impact on L.A. County residents' finances, and the Department of Consumer and Business Affairs' new Financial Navigators Program is here to help.

Financial Navigators can help you manage financial issues, identify immediate action steps, and make referrals to other services at no cost.

#### How to Get Help From A Financial Navigator

Visit [dcba.lacounty.gov/financial-navigators](https://dcba.lacounty.gov/financial-navigators) to complete a short interest form.

- The interest form will ask you for your name, zip code, language preference, phone and/or email address.
- Call 800-593-8222 if you need help completing the form.

A Financial Navigator will follow-up with you within 48 hours.



### WHAT HAPPENS DURING A FINANCIAL NAVIGATION SESSION?



1. The free session will last between 30 minutes to an hour.
2. A Financial Navigator will ask you a series of questions about your concerns.

\*Please note Financial Navigators provide personalized information; they cannot provide direct financial assistance like cash or loans. A Financial Navigator is not a long-term counselor who provides financial assistance.

Some topics that may be discussed during your session include:

- Prioritizing payments for expenses like housing, food, and insurance
- Maximizing income, through accessing unemployment benefits, emergency loans and other public benefits
- Managing debt by providing guidance on contacting and negotiating with creditors
- Avoiding scams

# CHILD CARE FOR ESSENTIAL & LOW-INCOME WORKERS

**PROGRAM**

**ELIGIBILITY**

**TIMELINE**

The Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors and the City of Los Angeles have dedicated part of their CARES Act funding to provide child care services (vouchers) for essential workers and low-income working parents during the COVID-19 pandemic. The Child Care Alliance of Los Angeles (CCALA) and its partner agencies will distribute these funds to eligible essential workers.

Eligible families must be:

- Essential workers or low-income working families (essential worker includes: parents/guardians working in essential services such as, the health care industry, emergency services, food and agriculture, and other businesses currently open as per the Governor's most recent guidelines)
- Must live in Los Angeles County
- Need child care to perform their essential work
- Is not able to work remotely
- Meet certain income eligibility
- If the family includes a two-parent household, both parents must either be essential workers or the other parent must be unable to provide care for the child due to incapacitation

Families who meet eligibility guidelines may receive emergency child care services for their children until December 30, 2020.

## CUIDADO INFANTIL PARA TRABAJADORES ESENCIALES Y DE BAJOS INGRESOS

### PROGRAMA

### ELIGIBILIDAD

### DISPONIBILIDAD

La Junta de Supervisores del Condado de Los Angeles y la Ciudad de Los Angeles han dedicado parte de sus fondos de la ley CARES para brindar servicios de cuidado infantil (subsidios) para trabajadores esenciales y padres trabajadores de bajos ingresos durante la pandemia de COVID-19. Child Care Alliance of Los Angeles (CCALA) y sus agencias asociadas distribuirán estos fondos a los trabajadores esenciales elegibles.

Las familias elegibles deben ser:

- Trabajadores esenciales o familias trabajadoras de bajos ingresos (el trabajador esencial incluye: padres / tutor legal que trabajan en servicios esenciales como la industria del cuidado de la salud, servicios de emergencia, alimentos y agricultura y otros negocios actualmente abiertos según las pautas más recientes del Gobernador)
- Debe vivir en el condado de Los Ángeles
- Necesitan cuidado infantil para realizar su trabajo esencial
- No puede trabajar de forma remota
- Cumplir con ciertos requisitos de ingresos
- Si la familia incluye un hogar de dos padres, ambos padres deben ser trabajadores esenciales o el otro padre debe ser incapaz de cuidar al niño debido a una incapacidad.

Las familias que cumplen con los requisitos de elegibilidad pueden recibir servicios de cuidado infantil de emergencia para sus hijos hasta el 30 de diciembre de 2020.
