THANK YOU PREMIER FEDERAL CREDIT UNION!

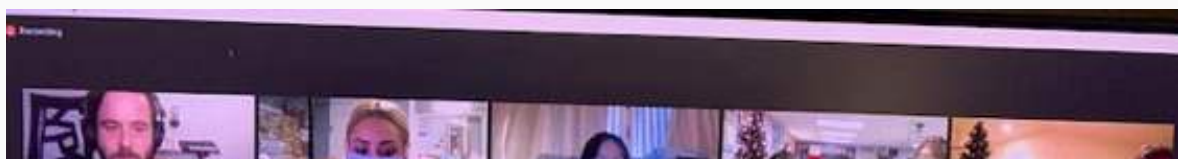
