LOWER INCOME WAITING LIST LOTTERY March 1, 2021 at 8:00am PST- March 12, 2021 at 4:00pm PST

Burbank Housing Corporation (BHC) is a nonprofit developer that owns 300+ affordable rental units in Burbank, CA. We maintain income-based waiting lists to fill all of our vacancies. The income guidelines for our program are established by the State of California for Los Angeles County.

Starting Monday, March 1, 2021 at 8:00 a.m. PST, BHC will begin accepting applications for our "Lower Income" Waiting List Lottery. Lottery applications must be submitted no later than Friday, March 12, 2021 at 4:00 p.m. PST. **All applications must be submitted online via our website**: <u>www.burbankhousingcorp.org.</u>

Once the application process closes, eligible applicants will be entered into a lottery system and a limited number of applications will be randomly selected and placed at the bottom of our "Lower Income" Waiting List. Please note that applying for the lottery does not guarantee you a position on our waiting list.

It may take several months or years on our waiting list before being placed in a BHC unit. For this reason, our Affordable Housing Program is <u>NOT</u> a form of immediate or emergency housing.

Due to the pandemic, our office is temporarily closed to the general public. If you wish to speak a BHC staff member, please contact our office during our normal hours of operation.

#### What is telehealth?

WCU's telehealth program provides nursing students the opportunity to learn while giving back to the community. Since telehealth is conducted over the phone, it is a great way for community members to learn about health concerns without having to visit a doctor's office.

#### What kind of health issues can telehealth support?

A telehealth appointment can provide you healthcare education in a variety of topics, including:

- COVID-19
- Mental Health
- NutritionFirst Aid
- Pediatrics
  Obstetrics
- Medication Administration
  - Senior Health

Existing Health Conditions

#### What should I expect on a telehealth call?

Initially, you will be contacted to schedule a time for a telehealth appointment. During your appointment, a WCU nursing professor and students will contact you by phone to discuss any health concerns you might want to learn about. They might ask if they can schedule a follow-up appointment to share additional resources.

#### What are the benefits?

Connect with nursing professionals and students to get better educated about your health, including learning more about COVID-19 safety.
