As we wind down 2022 and look forward to 2023, I'm reminded of the importance of community and what a vital role it plays for our Club. When we moved to our current facility, one of the many advantages of the space was that it could be shared with other organizations and companies.

Over the past year, we have worked with others to enhance our space and we've shared our gymnasium and Performing Arts Center with other organizations. We are so privileged to be part of a philanthropic community who prides itself on helping others.

Most recently, we had the Knorr company come out and help us refurbish our kitchen and the Lakers Youth Foundation also helped us re-do our basketball gymnasium. Warner Bros. Discovery was instrumental in helping us complete our Performing Arts Center. For the past two years, we've hosted adult and kids' basketball clinics in the gym in the evenings and our neighbors, the Story City Church, also use the Performing Arts Lobby for their congregation. 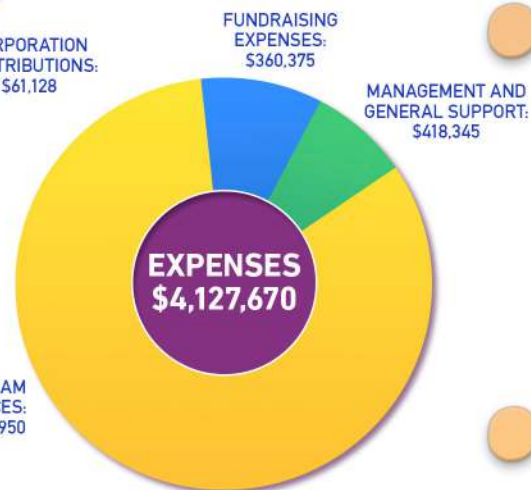
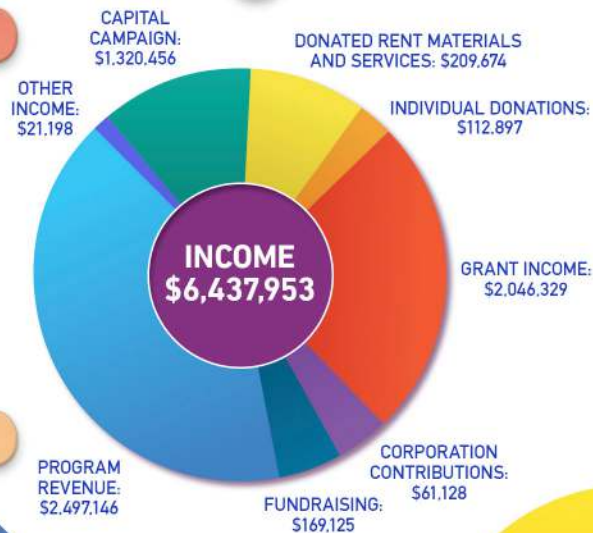
